## March 15 Remembrance Event – Roadwork Restrictions

Please be aware that there will be restrictions on work activities in place for the upcoming remembrance Event on 15 March 2020.

Restrictions will be in place between 16:00hrs Friday, 13 March and 09:00hrs Monday, 16 March 2020

- 1. Contractors with existing sites may be asked to reduce the impact or remove the site on one or more of these day, a TTM team member will contact contractors should worksite amendment or removal be required.
- 2. For contractors who plan to undertake works utilising Generic Plans, within the areas shown on the attached map, works will not be permitted on these days.
- 3. For contractors who plan to undertake works utilising Generic Plans, on Level 2 roads, works will not be permitted on these days.
- 4. Work activities may be permitted to continue where specific permission has been granted by a CTOC Traffic Management Team member. Please contact the CTOC TTM duty mailbox to request permission.
- 5. Works on the network, other than on restricted roads, within the CTOC area remain unimpacted by these restrictions.
- 6. Please note that these restrictions apply to not only works planned to be undertaken, but any worksite layout entered into Myworksites after the 28<sup>th</sup> of February 2020 where an unattended worksite is required on the days listed.
- 7. Works may return to normal from 09:01hrs Monday 16 March 2020.
