Hearing: Christchurch City Council building on the 8 July 2020.

[1] This is a decision concerning an application for a new Manager's Certificate by **Kelvin Tan-Cuong Inthavong**. The application was received on 4 September 2018 in relation to his employment at "Vietnam Kitchen" where he was owner and chef. The Committee had been advised that the premises have been visited and found to have ceased trading.

[2] The Inspector has opposed the application on the grounds of the applicant failing to show that he had the required knowledge of the Act at his first interview, pursuant to s. 222(c) of the Act. He did not turn up for a rescheduled second interview and has failed to produce a copy of the Licence Controllers Qualification.

[3] Attempts to contact the applicant and advise of the hearing have failed and the matter was duly set down for a hearing on the 8 July 2020 at 10.20 am at the Council Building. The applicant failed to attend and as a result the Committee was unable to ascertain the required information.

[4] The Committee's decision is that this application is declined on the grounds of the applicant not supplying the required information.
