Hills Road Detour - Slater Street traffic changes

URGENT: SLATER STREET TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

- Downer and Council have been made aware of dangerous driving at the intersection of Guild Street and Slater Street, with reports of some drivers ignoring the road signs that are in place.
- Downer and Council take road safety matters very seriously, and have engaged traffic planners to urgently review the current road layout and to suggest further safety measures.
- The traffic management changes are for the ongoing safety of all road users while the Hills Road culvert is being built.

SLATER STREET - TRAFFIC CHANGES

- **Starting Wednesday 28 June,** Slater Street (northbound) will be blocked at the Guild Street intersection.
- There will be no right turn into Guild Street from Slater Street.
- Road cones will be in place blocking traffic from taking either of these routes (see adjacent map).
