What we are doing

We are reopening some sections of Stapletons Road to two way traffic this week. Please read this update to find out how this will affect you.

Monday 30 April 2018

The northern end of Stapletons Road will be reopened to two way traffic see Map 1 overleaf.

Thursday 3 May 2018

The northern end of Stapletons Road will be chip sealed. There will be temporary traffic management whilst this happens (around two hours).

Stapletons Road between Averill Street and Dudley Street will also have some sections chip sealed.

Friday 4 May

Road markings on Stapletons Road between Averill Street and Dudley Street will be reinstated and the road will be reopened to two way traffic **on or before Monday 7 May.**

There are substantial road works happening on North Avon Road which may affect your onward route. See ccc.govt.nz/works for more information.

General information

Our standard work hours are Monday to Friday between the hours of 7.00am and 6.00pm and Saturday between 7.30am and 1pm.

Work can be delayed by bad weather. Work such as line marking or chip sealing may have to be postponed if it rains. It is not always possible for a crew to come back the next day, because they may be booked elsewhere.

"Will you be closing the road again?"

There will be further work on or near Stapletons Road over the next few weeks. We will use traffic management (rather than road closures) to do this work.

Important Information about chip sealing.

- Until the road is swept it's a good idea to take off your shoes before going in your house. Chips caught in your shoes can damage some types of floor covering.
- When the chip seal is new it's best to drive steady and slow over it. This protects your car from stone chips and gives a better finish.
- The road will be swept at a suitable time to give the best finish. This could be some days later. There may be loose chips on the road so drive to the conditions.
