TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR TEMPORARY WATER CONNECTIONS

Christchurch City's urban residents enjoy some of the best drinking water in the world. The Christchurch City Council maintains the water supply infrastructure of Christchurch and manages the application and approval of any temporary water connections.

The Council's Water Supply, Wastewater and Stormwater Bylaw 2014 requires that no person may take water from standpipes or hydrants or connect to Council's reticulation without written approval.

This includes connecting to residential or commercial connections for the purpose of conducting works on public land.

Approval of this application constitutes an agreement, and understanding, that the applicant (The Consumer) will meet the Council's requirements under the Local Government Act, Water Supply, Wastewater and Stormwater Bylaw 2014, Council's Terms and Conditions and the Council's agents hire agreement requirements.

You must ensure any person acting on the company's behalf in accessing the Christchurch City Councils reticulation is aware of these terms and conditions.

You must not damage, remove or tamper with the water meter, backflow preventer or any other part of the hydrant standpipe.

If at any stage during the hire period the standpipe is damaged or fails to work in the manner intended, it will be immediately returned to Council's agent for an integrity check.

Only a Council approved Hydrant standpipe or Temporary connection may be used to draw water on a temporary basis from the Christchurch City Council's reticulation system.

You, and any employee or person acting on the company's behalf must comply with all other Bylaws or Council requirements, including but not limited to, the appropriate traffic management plans being in place while drawing water from the reticulation system.

The Christchurch City Council reserves the right to withdraw, suspend or cancel your approval to draw water from the reticulation without notice and you release the Christchurch City Council to any loss or inconvenience resulting in such action.
