Q. Current budget for the Horseshoe Lake work currently being carried out in the carpark area.

A. The current work to remove the earthquake damaged footbridge and car park and to rebuild new car parking, walking track and landscaping is \$446,528

Q. Does the Horseshoe Lake work above include the re-instatement of the walkway from the carpark to the New Brighton road walkway.

A. The existing walking track around Lake Terrace Road is still open and usable.

1. How much money since 1998 to date has gone from Orion New Zealand Limited to support the Canterbury Employers' Chamber of Commerce for each year in total?
2. How much money did the Council give towards Rt Hon Helen Clark talk in the Town Hall this month? Please show the requests and way in writing the funding was sought and approved
3. Total and future cost of Christchurch town Hall from the closure due to earthquake they plan to be spent to finish it in total up 2022
