 Sense of Place 84% (n=632) of respondents living in Linwood-Central-Heathcote enjoy living in their neighbourhood. The top reasons for this are:	 Safety While the majority of respondents feel safe in their home after dark (84%, n=633) and walking in their neighbourhood during the day (88%, n=667), there are significantly less respondents who feel safe walking alone in their neighbourhood after dark (48%, n=362). Leadership Respondents are divided as to whether their community is addressing the most important issues affecting their neighbourhood; 27% (n=191) agree or strongly agree, and 28% (n=197) disagree or strongly disagree. Problem Assessment While 42% (n=275) have a good understanding of the needs of their neighbourhood, 34% (222) neither agree nor disagree with this statement, and a further 17% (n=113) disagree or strongly disagree. Discrimination 20% (n=129) of respondents have been discriminated against in the last 12 months. This is significantly higher than the overall results for respondents (15%, n=423). 43% (n=56) say the discrimination took place on the street or in a public place. 34% (n=44) say they think the discrimination occurred because of their age. In the 2020 – 2022 Community Board Plan, a priority to 'Support and Improve Community Wellbeing' is included. The priority will aim to address the above issues to some extent.
