Introduction of TTM Planner Warrant

CTOC would like to remind the industry that there is an imminent deadline for TMP plan designers to hold, or be enrolled on a workshop to gain, a TTM Planner Warrant.

The key dates are as follows:

- TTM Planners must either hold the warrant or be enrolled on a TTM Planner workshop by 1 April 2020
- There will be a phase in period through to 1 September 2020 to allow time for people to attend training and complete the assessment
- By 1 September 2020, all TMPs submitted for approval must be prepared by a CoPTTM warranted TTM Planner
- The availability of training workshops will continue following 1 September 2020 to cover changing roles.
