

THE APPLICANT HAS BEEN OPERATING THIS BUSINESS WITHOUT SERVING ALCOHOL SINCE DECEMBER 2023. THERE IS NO REASON TO BELIEVE EITHER NUISANCE OR VANDALIZM WILL OCCUR, THE TEAM MONITOR ALL OF THEIR CUSTOMERS AND NO ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR WILL BE TOLERATED.

 - There is a small administration charge for our assistance in loading the content onto the licensing notification webpage. The fee will need to be paid in advance of publication.
 - Your notice will be published within a week of your application being received and the public notice fee being paid.
- 2. We will send you a copy of the published notice for your records at the same time we send you the front entrance notice for display on your premises. You will need to display the notice on your main entrance for at least 25 working days.
- 3. Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).

11. Payment

You will be issued an invoice at your lodgement meeting when you file your application. Payment of Fees MUST be made immediately on receiving the invoice.

Please note, your full application, including name and contact details will be used by Council staff to assess and provided to decision makers. Your application, with names only will be available on our website. However, if requested under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987, we may disclose applications including personal details. If you feel there are reasons why your contact details and/or personal details should be kept confidential, please contact us.

The information will be provided to the statutory reporting agencies (the Police, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Council's Licensing Inspectors) for the purposes of assessing and reporting on your application, and to the Christchurch District Licensing Committee for the purposes of making a decision on your application. This information may form part of a public hearing of your application before the Christchurch District Licensing Committee and may be used in the Committee's decision for your application. Decisions will be made publicly available.

The Council is required to keep a record of every premises licence application (including for renewals and variations) filed with the District Licensing Committee and the Committee's decision on it. This information (which includes the application and all attachments) is made available to the Council's Licensing Inspectors, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Police for the purposes of monitoring ongoing compliance with any licence conditions and undertakings, Duty Manager appointments, and the Act.

14. Processing Timelines:
