We promote responsible alcohol consumption by ensuring our staff are trained to identify irresponsible drinking behavior, display appropriate signage and advertising, we limit alcohol promotions, our menu of drinks available has a higher percentage of non-alcoholic vs alcohol drinks, provide alternative transport when required and we ensure prohibited people including minors are not served on the premises

d. What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed?

We ensure alcohol is not sold to prohibited persons by ensuring are staff are trained, that they are also well supported by senior staff members/duty managers during operating hours. We display signage of expected behavior, outcome of poor behavior and legal drinking age while also policing designated areas with our facility

e. To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations (and locations)

We offer water in the following ways and locations - (i) Free chilled water from a water station located at the main counter and accessible for the bar area (cups are provided), (ii) Free water is available over the counter from one of our team members, (iii) Patrons can purchase bottled water if they prefer

- f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?
 - (i) Staff are adequately trained on the sale and supply of alcohol act, (ii) Sufficient certified duty managers to cover all operating hours, (iii) Team members receive on going training and reminder of obligations under the act, (iv) Regular internal compliance audits performed by management to identify performance gaps and training opportunities
- g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Our venue provides very low risk of noise related issues due to the hours we operate both during the week and on weekends coupled with the nature of our business. As primarily an indoor sports and leisure venue which does not operate with loud music playing while also being located in an industrial area, disruption to the surrounding community is not expected. Any noise generated by the business is contained with the facility.

- h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?
 - We consider the opportunity of nuisance or vandalism generated from our venue to be very low. To mitigate at root cause we ensure staff are trained to be identify and handle irresponsible drinking which lowers the risk or poor decision making. Additionally the hours which the venue operates including the bar area and the primary nature of our business (e.g. sports & leisure) also contributes to our business being a low risk oper
- i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

The closest licenced premise to us is 1.2km (North East) and 2.2km (South West). These are both Pubs or Restaurants which primary source of entertainment is different to our business of sports/leisure activities. We also ensure our staff are adequately trained to be able to identify and handle irresponsible drinking or serving prohibited people which lowers the risk of patrons leaving the premises and making poor decisions.

j. What is the land near the proposed premises being used for? Will the granting of a licence for your premises impact on changing neighbouring land use? If so, in what way?

Land in our immediate vicinity are established commercial and industrial businesses that have existed for many years. Although the licence is new to us, the location/business has operated under a licence with previous owners therefore I see no evidence to suggest granting our licence would change the way in which neighbouring land users operate.
