9. Host Responsibility

- a.Food menus attached
 - Non-alcoholic refreshments tap water (free at all times), Soft Drinks,
 Antipodes Sparkling & Still Water, Arepa Brain Drinks, Assorted Juices, Iced
 Tea, Mocktails, Tea & Coffee
 - Low Alcoholic Beverages Light Beers
- b. We have a full time Concierge who will call guests or dial a driver. We work with all Christchurch taxis, but our preferred company is Corporate Cabs. We offer to call all guests a taxi at the conclusion of their meal and are happy for them to leave their car on premises to collect the following day if necessary.
- c. All our Supervisory staff in Food & Beverage hold their LCQ or are put on the course shortly after they commence employment with us. We serve every guest who sits in our Bar/Lobby area iced water when they sit down and keep this replenished while they are with us. Staff who hold Manager's Certificates attend an internal two day Duty Manager's Course that the hotel conducts on a regular basis to educate them further on managing the safe supply of alcohol. We invite the Police to come and speak at this Course.
- d. Training for all Food & Beverage staff on safe service of alcohol is compulsory and we sign off on competency within their first week of training in the department. Signage is prevalent in our Bar/POS area. We check identification for guests purchasing alcohol who look 25 years or younger. We communicate across outlets to identify guests who are underage or becoming intoxicated.
- e. Everywhere in the hotel. Our Restaurant, Functions Department and Bar all serve complimentary tap water on seating as a standard. Our Hotel Reception Desk has complimentary water available on the desk also.
- f. All our Supervisory staff in Food & Beverage hold their LCQ or are put on the course shortly after they commence employment with us. We have at least one staff member per outlet who holds their General Manager's Certificate the hotel elects the appropriate staff to acquire this periodically and funds the process. Our staff who hold General Manager's Certificates attend an internal two day Duty Manager's Course that the hotel conducts on a regular basis to educate them further on managing the safe supply of alcohol. We invite the Police to come and speak at this Course. Training for all Food & Beverage staff on safe service of alcohol is compulsory and we sign off on competency within their first week of training in the department.

- g. Occasionally we have live bands playing for functions. We inform all bands playing on the premises to keep base to a minimum level. We do not allow drum kits for bands playing at any event.
 We have a 12Midnight curfew for noise and monitor at the time to minimise impact on other guests.
- h. Nuisance and vandalism is highly unlikely on our premises if this was to occur we would charge the guest who was responsible for any damage and prohibit them from entering our premises in future.
- Victoria Street restaurants and bars and Hotel Montreal.
 No The George restaurant and Functions area are not conducive to any sort of high alcohol consumption and attract a clientele whose demographic typically do not indulge in binge drinking.
