d. What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed?

Any guest looks under 25 years to be asked for ID. Security hosts checking ID when required i.e. only on busier nights. Staff training. Staff, Managers, Security monitorin intoxication and looking for the S.C.A.B. signs. Slow consumption with food/water.

e. To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations (and locations)

Each bar has approved water dispensers and glassware available. Water bottles will be made available at the bar for guests to take to their table in the main bars. We also offer free "Drivers Splits" (Sodas)

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

Staff encouraged to complete ServeWise program and receive a 50c per hour wage increase on completion. Managers coaching staff. Included in meetings agenda.

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Operations Manager has met with owner (Sid McAuly) and we have an open line of communication and dialog, no communication required for over 1 year. We have purchased a noise meter to randomly check.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Potential nuisance/vandalisum is monitored by security hosts as guests leave on busier evenings. Dux Central, Smash Palace, Cascade and Soul Quarter all share the same security company and are in close contact via radio. Security camera servaillance inlcuding along Poplar St.

i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

Little High and Earl Restaurant - prodominantly food oriented. Smash Palace - very different clientele to Dux Central. Given the variety of clientele there is little cross-over of visitation.
