c) What other steps does the applicant propose to take aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol?

The current licence prohibits the applicant from -

- selling singles of beer, cider or RTDs priced at, or less than, \$6.00;
- selling nitro or similar products; and
- deliveries of alcohol via Uber (condition (f)).

Alcohol-related promotions, discounts, or advertisements is always conducted with responsibility and never in a way that encourages irresponsible consumption. Staff have access to the Intoxication Assessment Tool, which will be prominently displayed for reference.

d) What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed?

Signs are displayed at the premises clearly stating that the sale of alcohol to individuals who are underage or intoxicated is prohibited. Staff will verify the ID of individuals who look younger than 25 years old. Those who are underage are not permitted to enter the premises unless they are in the company of a parent or a legally appointed guardian. Additionally, entry is denied to anyone showing signs of being under the influence of alcohol.

e) To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations (and locations)

Drinking water is freely available during any tastings.

f) What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

To ensure that staff perform their duties with due diligence and are aware of their legal responsibilities, they receive ongoing training. CCTV cameras is installed to oversee activities and bolster security. Both the interior and exterior of the premises is adequately lit and maintained in an orderly fashion. The lighting inside the premises is sufficient for staff to check ID and monitor customers. Additionally, the point of sales system is configured to remind staff to verify the ID of customers prior to finalising any sales.

g) What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Given the premises operates as a retail activity, concerns regarding noise are unlikely to arise. The applicant is not aware of any noise related concerns arising from the premises since it has taken over.

h) What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

The applicant is not aware of any incidents related to nuisance and vandalism concerning the premises. There is sufficient lighting inside and outside to deter loiterers. There is CCTV and will continue to be used for monitoring and security purposes. The premises is within a commercial complex among other businesses/retailers/food and beverage outlets.

Customers are encouraged to raise any concerns with a duty manager and/or director regarding noise, nuisance, and vandalism. An incident register is kept and maintained to monitor any such concerns.

 i) What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

Super Liquor Ferrymead on Waterman Place is approximately 850 northwest of the premises.

Super Liquor Woolston on Ferry Road is approximately 2.5km north of the premises.

Liquorland Woolston is approximately 2.4km north of the premises.

The premises is an existing premises and has been operating in this locality for some time without any issues or concerns. The applicant has sufficient systems in place to ensure that sale and supply of alcohol is undertaken safely and responsibly.

j) What is the land near the proposed premises being used for? Will the granting of a licence for your premises impact on changing neighbouring land use? If so, in what way?

The land near the premises is being used mainly for commercial/retail purposes. There are various food and beverage outlets in the same complex as the premises. The granting of the renewal is not expected to impact the neighbouring land use, as the area is already zoned for commercial/retail activity and other businesses are operating in close proximity.

The nature and scale of the alcohol retail activity is consistent with the existing use of the area and will not lead to any significant changes in neighbouring land use.
