U18 (Minors), intoxicated persons and other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold in line with the licence will be declined. Persons who look under 25, will be asked for identification. Persons dressed in school uniform will not be served regardless of their age. (Staff will use discretion, regarding fancy dress).

e. To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations (and locations)

Water will aways be provided/available at tastings or by request, as it is a Bottle Store.

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

All staff abide by our licence, Local LAP, Government legislation and their own Duty Managers Licence. Any changes are notified to staff and regular updates are conveyed. Good staff communications regarding customers and trouble shooting busy periods.NA

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

NA - Have not been an issue to date and we are not anticipating any in the future.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Unfortunately vandalism affects everyone in the community and ram raids/vandalism are not just selective to Bottle stores. We have bollards, metal bars, fog cannon, glass sensitive alarm system, a wonderful volunteer local community watch and great police, to do our best to deter nuisance and vandalism incidents.

i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

Armadilo restaurant and bar is next door to our premises. We have a good relationship with the locals and staff and have not encountered any problems or anticipate any in the future.

The Oaks is a small community shopping centre, providing physio, chemist, pizza, take aways, Roti Chi restaurant, fish shop dairy and Armadillos restaurant/bar, all complimenting each other.
