Bar staff are trained to appropriately and responsibly sell alcohol and to stop serving if any question on age of patron or if they are showing signs of intoxication. Offer low and non-alcoholic drinks and alternative transport options.

Drinking water is available over the bar and also a cooling water fountain is behind one of the squash courts. During a function jugs of water are available on the bar for patrons to help themselves to water

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

All bar staff are trained to check ID when serving if there is any question regarding a patrons age. Staff are also trained not to serve anyone under the influence and will close a function down if any sign of disorderly behaviour occurs.

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

The manager on duty liaises with the person in control of the music and asks for the volume to be turned down when neccessary. Keep windows and doors closed to mitigate noise level and have an airconditioning unit that is used to assist with managing temperature in the lounge area.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Premises are alarmed and have security cameras. Alarm monitoring is done by Code 9. Carpark area is checked frequently by staff during nights when functions are held

i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

Rugby Club (Christchurch)

No change to planned activities at the club so no promotion of alcohol. Our activities revolve around sports activities to a wide age group.
