All permanent Duty Managers have completed their LCQ training and have their Managers Certificates. We have one staff member who is waiting on the Duty Mgrs Cert to be printed. Another who is waiting on their interview and another who is completing the LCQ course. Head Chef/ Shift Supervisor on site at all times

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

We have been operating at this site since 1997 and have never had a noise complaint made against us. We are incredibly mindful of this when hosting functions. We are not located in a residential area

- h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

  As above, also we only offer to host functions for those customers who we are certain will not create problems
- i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

No. There are 2 other Cafes in the area and they have been operating for a number of years, however we were the 1st in the area and the other were granted licences after us. There have been no issues in the past and in our view there will not be an increase in issues due to our license being renewed.
