All alcohol licence application public notices are published on the dedicated webpage located on ccc.govt.nz/alcohol. Applications are no longer required to be published in the local newspaper.

- 1. We will take care of the publication of your public notice when you make your application to us,
 - There is a small administration charge for our assistance in loading the content onto the licensing notification webpage. The fee
 will need to be paid in advance of publication.
 - · Your notice will be published within a week of your application being received and the public notice fee being paid.
- 2. We will send you a copy of the published notice for your records at the same time we send you the front entrance notice for display on your premises. You will need to display the notice on your main entrance for at least 25 working days.
- Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the
 applicant must ensure that notice of this application is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this
 application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).

Privacy Statement

Information contained in your application and any supporting information will be held by Christchurch City Council to enable your application to be processed under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. Please note, your full application, including name and contact details will be used by Council staff to assess and provided to decision makers. Your application, with names only will be available on our website. However, if requested under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987, we may disclose applications including personal details. If you feel there are reasons why your contact details and/or personal details should be kept confidential, please contact us.

The information will be provided to the statutory reporting agencies (the Police, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Council's Licensing Inspectors) for the purposes of assessing and reporting on your application, and to the Christchurch District Licensing Committee for the purposes of making a decision on your application. This information may form part of a public hearing of your application before the Christchurch District Licensing Committee and may be used in the Committee's decision for your application. Decisions will be made publicly available.

The Council is required to keep a record of every premises licence application (including for renewals and variations) filed with the District Licensing Committee and the Committee's decision on it. This information (which includes the application and all attachments) is made available to the Council's Licensing Inspectors, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Police for the purposes of monitoring ongoing compliance with any licence conditions and undertakings, Duty Manager appointments, and the Act.

The Council is required to report statistics about applications to the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority.

Any member of the public may, under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987, request access to information held by the Council. The Privacy Act 2020 applies to the Council and under that Act, you have the right to see and correct personal information that the Council holds about you.

14. Processing Timelines:

Manager Certificate applications should be made well before your certificate is required. On average about 5-6 weeks is required for a standard application to allow for processing, statutory reporting on your application, and issuing of a District Licensing Committee (DLC) decision on your licence. Timelines will be longer if there are agency oppositions or missing information on your application. More information about statutory timelines can be found at cc.govt.nz/alcohol

9 Conditions

Host Responsibility

Food will always be available. Its availability will be advertised by signage and its consumption will be encouraged by staff, so as to slow the onset of intoxication.

A range of sodas, post-mix, non-alcoholic cocktails, tea and coffee will always be available. Tap water will be provided free of charge, either from the bar or from designated built-in water stations.

A range of Low-alcohol and Zero-alcohol beers and ciders will always be available. Spirits will be served as singles where requested.

- b.

 A telephone will always be available for patrons to call a taxi. Taxis will be promoted as a safe transport option. Signage will also displayed to reflect this.
- c. We will provide free post-mix drinks to designated drivers. Staff will be proactive in recommending food and non-alcoholic drinks. We will comply with regulations regarding discounting of drinks and the advertising thereof.
- d.

 All staff will be trained to ask for identification, and will refuse service and communicate with management and security if in doubt as to age or intoxication.
- e.

 Tap water will be provided free of charge, either from the bar, in jugs at restaurant tables, or from a designated built-in water station, accessible without staff interaction.
- f.
 Staff will undergo training as part of the induction process before commencing work in regards to their responsibilities under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. This will be supplemented by regular refresher training sessions, as well as on-the-job training. There will be multiple qualified managers working on higher-risk shifts, such as Friday or Saturday evenings, so as to provide support for the Duty Manager and Security staff regarding compliance issues. The Duty Manager will always be a 'rostered extra', and will be free to roam the premises and ensure compliance, rather than being stuck behind the bar.
- g.

 Noise levels will be monitored by the Duty Manager. Outdoor speakers are angled so as to minimise sound carrying. There are no 'close by' neighbours.

h.

Our management and security staff monitor the premises and the surrounding areas for vandalism, nuisance etc. and aim to prevent disorderly behavior before it occurs/escalates. CCTV will monitor the interior and exterior of the premises to act as a deterrent.

i.

There are two licensed premises in the immediate vicinity.

We take our obligations under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 very seriously and, as such, are extremely diligent and forthright in dealing with any compliance issues, so as to ensure the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol is undertaken safely and responsibly, and the harm caused by the excessive or inappropriate consumption of alcohol is minimized.
