Water provided on all tables upon ordering. Food menu provided when ordering drinks.

Table service to ensure no intoxicated person is served another drink.

d. What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed? All staff regularly trained on how to request and read ID and how to raise any issues or concerns with the customers.

e. To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations and locations)

Chilled water available when requested.

A plumbed filter system is in place, with bottles and glasses in the main area of the cafe in clear view.

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

All staff regularly trained on the responsible sale of alcohol and what to do in regard to asking for ID, intoxicated persons and minors. A duty manager will be present at all times.

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Cafe is located in a non-resident area and is situated on a busy main road with other hospitality business in the same row. Request customers leave in a quiet manner and consider the neighbours on their way home.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them? No instances of nuisance or vandalism. We will implement a zero-tolerance policy and will report any instances to local law enforcement.



i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

Sprig and Fern, Aikmans, Brewers.
We are unaware of any alcohol related problems in the area and the level of activity by granting this licence will be minimal due the small size of the cafe/wine bar, no separate bar area available and the age range the cafe and wine bar attracts.

j. What is the land near the proposed premises being used for? Will the granting of a licence for your premises impact on changing neighbouring land use? If so, in what way?

All neighbouring land is retail, hospitality, personal and professional services. The granting of this certificate will have no impact on the neighbouring businesses.

- 1. We will take care of the publication of your public notice when you make your application to us.
  - There is a small administration charge for our assistance in loading the content onto the licensing notification webpage. The fee will need to be paid in advance of publication.
  - · Your notice will be published within a week of your application being received and the public notice fee being paid.
- 2. We will send you a copy of the published notice for your records at the same time we send you the front entrance notice for display on your premises. You will need to display the notice on your main entrance for at least 25 working days.
- 3. Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).

You will be issued an invoice at your lodgement meeting when you file your application. Payment of Fees MUST be made immediately on receiving the invoice.

Please note, your full application, including name and contact details will be used by Council staff to assess and provided to decision makers. Your application, with names only will be available on our website. However, if requested under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987, we may disclose applications including personal details. If you feel there are reasons why your contact details and/or personal details should be kept confidential, please contact us.

The information will be provided to the statutory reporting agencies (the Police, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Council's Licensing Inspectors) for the purposes of assessing and reporting on your application, and to the Christchurch District Licensing Committee for the purposes of making a decision on your application. This information may form part of a public hearing of your application before the Christchurch District Licensing Committee and may be used in the Committee's decision for your application. Decisions will be made publicly available.

The Council is required to keep a record of every premises licence application (including for renewals and variations) filed with the District Licensing Committee and the Committee's decision on it. This information (which includes the application and all attachments) is made available to the Council's Licensing Inspectors, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Police for the purposes of monitoring ongoing compliance with any licence conditions and undertakings, Duty Manager appointments, and the Act.

The Council is required to report statistics about applications to the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority.

## 14. Processing Timelines:

Manager Certificate applications should be made well before your certificate is required. On average about 5-6 weeks is required for a standard application to allow for processing, statutory reporting on your application, and issuing of a District Licensing Committee (DLC) decision on your licence. Timelines will be longer if there are agency oppositions or missing information on your application.
