Noise is generally not an issue for off-licensed premises. To the best of our knowledge, the store has not generated noise complaints since the licensee took possession.

To the best of our knowledge, there have been no issues that can be directly attributed to the sale of alcohol from this store.

This is for the renewal of licence for an existing store. It is unlikely that the renewal of licence will increase ARH in the vicinity.

The area is predominantly commercial, the Hornby High School is across the road, and residential properties are to the north west of the site.

- 3. Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application in form 7 is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).
