b. What steps does the applicant propose to take to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises, for staff and patrons?

We have a transport management plan with the council, we offer a free taxi call and recommend patrons use ubers, taxis and public transport. We also provide bike racks for bikes and encourage the use of buses and walking.

c. What other steps does the applicant propose to take aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol?

We have signage behind the bar recommending responsible consumption. If tastings of wine are provided then water and a spitoon will be provided. our staff are able to provide info on safe transport. We give every table water bottles and monitor signs of intox carefully

d. What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed?

Wine sold to take home will not be sold to intoxicated persons. Any customer who looks under the age of 25 are asked to show valid ID. Staff are trained to ask for ID and to look for signs of intoxication. Our duty manager monitors this constantly. No ID no service

e. To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations (and locations)

Water is freely available and replenished on each table in a large Litre bottle. Sparkling water is also available to purchase

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

Every staff member is trained and overseen by duty managers, we encourage the use of servewise as a training tool and have regular meetings with staff to keep retraining. we are a small family owned business and take strong measures to ensure compliance with the law

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

The noise levels are low as per our noise management plan with the council. Any even events are finished by 10pm. No amplified music and our accommodation is beside the restaurant so we encourage any late quests to leave quietly

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

These are low, we close our gates at night and we are at the end of a road that turns into a walking track.

i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

New World St Martins is a 5minute drive, or a long walk down the hill. The Brickworks is our closest other venue and a 5 minute drive away

A mix of residential and Port Hills rural land. Neighbours have signed documents to agree with our resource consent and are happy with our developments.

- 2. We will send you a copy of the published notice for your records at the same time we send you the front entrance notice for display on your premises. You will need to display the notice on your main entrance for at least 25 working days.
- 3. Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application in form 7 is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).
