- Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee,
 the applicant must ensure that notice of this application in form 7 is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site

The Council is required to keep a record of every premises licence application (including for renewals and variations) filed with the District Licensing Committee and the Committee's decision on it. This information (which includes the application and all attachments) is made available to the Council's Licensing Inspectors, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Police for the purposes of monitoring ongoing compliance with any licence conditions and undertakings, Duty Manager appointments, and the Act.

Renewal with Variations will not be accepted without an Inspector Verification being completed.

15. Processing Timelines:

Manager Certificate applications should be made well before your certificate is required. On average about 5-6 weeks is required for a standard application to allow for processing, statutory reporting on your application, and issuing of a District Licensing Committee (DLC) decision on your licence.
