we have several jugs of cold water in our fridge we prepare everyday, when we see a table of customers wine drinks, we provide them a jug of water ASAP and light snacks. We also offer a range low-alcohol refreshments to patrons at all times.

No current noise levels or complaints, future noise levels can come from loud, rowdy patrons for BYO. We will have to ask the patrons to lower their noise levels or we will have to ask them to leave

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Currently we have homeless people lurking around our property, looking through our windows and waiting for us around the carpark. We are also in an area wwere graffiti and vandalism is a high possibility. We have multiple cameras instore to record activity and we will report suspcious activity to the police



i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

The closet licensed premise next to us is Saigon centre, there isnt any other restaurants close to us. Saigon are very busy saturdays with BYO's, compared to us with quite Saturdays. I don't think this licence will contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area, I have been around this area for a several months now, and have not heard or seen any conflicts, this could be due to the fact we are very close bars that mainly serve alcohol

 - · Your notice will be published within a week of your application being received and the public notice fee being paid.
- 2. We will send you a copy of the published notice for your records at the same time we send you the front entrance notice for display on your premises. You will need to display the notice on your main entrance for at least 25 working days.
- 3. Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).

You will be issued an invoice at your lodgement meeting when you file your application. Payment of Fees MUST be made immediately on receiving the invoice.

If you feel there are reasons why your contact details and/or personal details should be kept confidential, please contact us.

The information will be provided to the statutory reporting agencies (the Police, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Council's Licensing Inspectors) for the purposes of assessing and reporting on your application, and to the Christchurch District Licensing Committee for the purposes of making a decision on your application. This information may form part of a public hearing of your application before the Christchurch District Licensing Committee and may be used in the Committee's decision for your application. Decisions will be made publicly available.

The Council is required to keep a record of every premises licence application (including for renewals and variations) filed with the District Licensing Committee and the Committee's decision on it. This information (which includes the application and all attachments) is made available to the Council's Licensing Inspectors, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Police for the purposes of monitoring ongoing compliance with any licence conditions and undertakings, Duty Manager appointments, and the Act.

14. Processing Timelines:

Manager Certificate applications should be made well before your certificate is required. On average about 5-6 weeks is required for a standard application to allow for processing, statutory reporting on your application, and issuing of a District Licensing Committee (DLC) decision on your licence.
