We will display signs detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.

Point of sale software prompts operators to confirm age and locks the sale until a supervisor releases it. Our customer service team are trained to watch out for multiple purchases by "at Risk" customers, in addition to any attempts to purchase alcohol by intoxicated or underage customers

e. To what extent, where, and how is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons? (i.e. explain whether water is bar service only, water jugs, or plumbed water stations (and locations)

If we are doing demos on wine then bottled water is available at the demo table.

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

We use a web based training system - Red seed that requires all our customer service team members to undergo training and they complete an Online test covering the sale of Liquor.

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Liquorland Moorhouse keep within all known district authority noise levels.

h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

We have no knowledge of any deviant, antisocial and disruptive behavior resulting from the sale of liquor at Liquorland Moorhouse

. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

In the immediate area we have licensed restaurants, bars and liquor wholesalers. Jason William's has operated groceries stores and supermarkets for over 20 years and is a responsible operator.

j. What is the land near the proposed premises being used for? Will the granting of a licence for your premises impact on changing neighbouring land use? If so, in what way?

The Land in the surrounding area is used for business and there is no housing in the immediate area.

# 12. Important to note - Public notification of application

All alcohol licence application public notices are published on the dedicated webpage located on ccc.govt.nz/alcohol. Applications are no longer required to be published in the local newspaper.

     The fee will need to be paid in advance of publication.
  - · Your notice will be published within a week of your application being received and the public notice fee being paid.
- 2. We will send you a copy of the published notice for your records at the same time we send you the front entrance notice for display on your premises. You will need to display the notice on your main entrance for at least 15 working days.
- 3. Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application in form 7 is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).

This information will be made available to the public on request as part of the public notification of your application. The information will be provided to the statutory reporting agencies (the Police, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Council's Licensing Inspectors) for the purposes of assessing and reporting on your application, and to the Christchurch District Licensing Committee for the purposes of making a decision on your application. This Information may form part of a public hearing of your application before the Christchurch District Licensing Committee and may be used in the Committee's decision for your application. Decisions will be made publicly available.

The Council is required to keep a record of every premises licence application (including for renewals and variations) filed with the District Licensing Committee and the Committee's decision on it. This information (which includes the application and all attachments) is made available to the Council's Licensing Inspectors, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Police for the purposes of monitoring ongoing compliance with any licence conditions and undertakings, Duty Manager appointments, and the Act.

The Council is required to report statistics about applications to the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority,

On average about 5-6 weeks is required for a standard application to allow for processing, statutory reporting on your application, and issuing of a District Licensing Committee (DLC) decision on your licence. Timelines will be longer if there are agency oppositions or missing information on your application.
