A friendly, safe, quality dining experience is the primary focus of this hospitality venue.

- Non-alcoholic refreshments: Free water at the table and a comprehensive menu of non-alcohol beverages is provided.

- Low-alcoholic beverages (specify if you intend to have free water available at all times):

Free water at the table and a comprehensive menu of low alcohol and no-alcohol beverages is provided.

b. What steps does the applicant propose to take to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premise, for staff and patrons?

Signage and business cards of transport providers are available at the till. Staff use local bus services and provide advice to guests as required.

c. What other steps does the applicant propose to take aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol?

Our staff are predominantly qualified and knowledgeable, several having completed LCQ training. We have good communication channels between staff, Duty Managers and Directors. This ensures all are conversant with the responsibilities associated with operating a licensed venue. Maintaining acceptance by the local community as a safe, pleasant place to take family for lunch dinner requires we actively promote social responsibility in accordance with the Act around the consumption of alcohol on our premises.

d. What steps does the applicant propose to take to ensure that the requirements of the Act in relation to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons (i.e. minors, intoxicated persons, other persons to whom alcohol may not be sold pursuant to the licence) are observed?

Awareness and a sound Host Responsibility Policy are the key. Formaggio's has qualified, knowledgeable and experienced wait staff, Duty Managers and Directors. Communication channels are good with our people actively participating in the operation of the restaurant. All have an acute awareness of the need to maintain a safe and welcoming environment for people of all ages. We cannot allow this atmosphere to be damaged by breaching the specifics and the underlying intent of the Act.

e. To what extent, and where, is drinking water intended to be freely available to patrons?

Free chilled drinking water is provided to all tables as guests are welcomed. This is actively replenished as the guests dining experience evolves.

f. What appropriate systems, staff and training does/will the applicant have in place to ensure compliance with the law?

Staff are encouraged to gain their Licence Controller Qualifications. (The fees for the training are paid for any staff that choose to take up this opportunity. The restaurant manager and the Directors are regularly communicating with staff with regard to compliance and to Host Responsibility in general.

g. What are the current and possible future noise levels and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

Noise levels are very low and there are no proximate residential properties. Only recorded restaurant music is played inside. There are no external sound systems. The carpark is small, well lit and actively managed by staff each evening.

- h. What are the current and possible future levels of nuisance and vandalism and how does the applicant intend to mitigate them?

The site is visible and right beside the Beckenham Police Station. The carpark is well lit with flood light illumination during the hours of darkness. The premises are alarmed when not occupied. There have been no issues since we purchased the business in February 2016.

- i. What other licensed premises are there in the vicinity of this proposed premises? And, will the granting of this licence contribute to an increase in alcohol related problems in the area? (Explain)

The 150 Colombo Street location is part of a small hospitality hub with 4 restaurants and a restaurant bar in close proximity. It is a family-centric hospitality centre. The venue has been licenced for nearly 20 years and we do not anticipate or know of any material changes in the area.

The venue has been licenced for over 25 years and we do not anticipate or know of any material changes in the area.

All alcohol licence application public notices are published on the dedicated webpage located on ccc.govt.nz/alcohol. Applications are no longer required to be published in the local newspaper.

1. We will take care of the publication of your public notice when you make your application to us.
 - There is a small administration charge for our assistance in loading the content onto the licensing notification webpage. The fee will need to be paid in advance of publication.
 - Your notice will be published within a week of your application being received and the public notice fee being paid.
2. We will send you a copy of the published notice for your records at the same time we send you the front entrance notice for display on your premises. You will need to display the notice on your main entrance for at least 15 working days.
3. Except in the case of a conveyance, within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Committee, the applicant must ensure that notice of this application in form 7 is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which this application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).

Renewal with Variations will not be accepted without an Inspector Verification being completed.

13. Processing Timelines:

Premises applications should be made well before your licence is required. On average about 5-6 weeks is required for a standard application to allow for public notification, processing, statutory reporting on your application, and issuing of a District Licensing Committee (DLC) decision on your licence. Timelines will be longer if there are public objections or agency oppositions or missing information on your application. More information about statutory timelines can be found at ccc.govt.nz/alcohol

Privacy Statement

Information contained in your application and any supporting information will be held by Christchurch City Council to enable your application to be processed under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. This information will be made available to the public on request as part of the public notification of your application. The information will be provided to the statutory reporting agencies (the Police, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Council's Licensing Inspectors) for the purposes of assessing and reporting on your application, and to the Christchurch District Licensing Committee for the purposes of making a decision on your application. This information may form part of a public hearing of your application before the Christchurch District Licensing Committee and may be used in the Committee's decision for your application. Decisions will be made publicly available.

The Council is required to keep a record of every premises licence application (including for renewals and variations) filed with the District Licensing Committee and the Committee's decision on it. This information (which includes the application and all attachments) is made available to the Council's Licensing Inspectors, the Medical Officer of Health, and the Police for the purposes of monitoring ongoing compliance with any licence conditions and undertakings, Duty Manager Appointments, and the Act.

The Council is required to report statistics about applications to the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority.

Any member of the public may, under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987, request access to information held by the Council. The Privacy Act 1993 applies to the Council and under that Act, you have the right to see and correct personal information that the Council holds about you.
