We're developing a draft plan for a new Akaroa wharf to replace the existing one to meet the future needs of the community.

The current wharf had a structural condition assessment in late 2018 which identified that it is reaching the end of its useful life. This is due to the declining condition of its hardwood timbers, particularly those below water.

The 130 year old Akaroa wharf has significant cultural, historical and social values for the Akaroa community. Originally constructed for coastal shipping, the function and use of the wharf has changed over time as the needs and interests of the community changed. It is currently used by locals and visitors, for a range of commercial, tourism and recreational activities.












Aerial view of Akaroa wharf
