Even a large tree can die if it suffers regular damage over time.



Drip Line

You can help

- Slow down when manoeuvring around trees
- Keep lawn mowers and weed-eaters outside a tree's drip line
- Do not mow if you can't do so without causing damage to roots, trunks or low-hanging branches. Report low branches to parks.
