Project Update - Road reinstatement on Medway Street (Woodchester Ave to North Parade)

The Council's Dudley Creek Bypass flood mitigation works are now completed, and work to permanently reinstate the road in Medway Street can now start.

Unfortunately there has been a delay to starting this work. It was planned to start these works immediately after the land drainage works were completed. Delays in appointing a contractor now mean the works will not start until February 2018. We apologise for this delay and know you have had a long period of time with works on your street.

Prior to works commencing in February 2018, a Start Work Notice will be posted in the mailboxes of all residents in the street, including information about the contractor who will construct the works, and the timeframes for start and completion of the works. Please turn the page for the plan of the reinstatement.

Please be assured Council staff will work closely with the successful contractor to minimise timeframes and impacts to you as residents.

A temporary chip seal has been laid to ensure access to the street over the Christmas / New Year period.
