What is – I **V** Brighton?

The event was established in 2011. The purpose of the event is to celebrate, showcase and unite the greater Brighton community.

The event is held on Waitangi Day so we want to recognise and celebrate the significance of this day, as well as the special qualities of Brighton and its people.

Event organisation

I ♥ Brighton is organised by a planning group involving local organisations, they are: New Brighton Project, Youth Alive Trust, Christchurch Methodist Mission - New Brighton Wellbeing, Eastern Community Sport and Recreation, and the Christchurch City Council.

Event format

The event consists of approx. 40 to 50 locally focused groups mostly not for profit community, sport and recreation focused with a few small businesses.

There are information stalls, craft and market stalls (from the weekly Seaside Market), food stalls, and a great range of have-a-go activities provided by local groups/clubs.

There will be performances on a main stage (band rotunda) from local musician's and performances as well as Kapa Haka for the opening of the event. The music and vibe in this area is aimed at a relaxed 'Sunday afternoon' feeling.

There will also be a range of preschool and children's entertainment.

There are three event areas to choose from Active Zone, Preschool Zone, Performance/Market Zone (refer to the site plan for these locations):

- There is no site fee for the below three options, but space is limited.
- Groups are encouraged to bring their own gazebos or we can provide you with one 3m x 3m pop up gazebo. All groups must provide their own tables and chairs. We do not provide power.
- Stall holder set up time begins from 9am and cars must be removed from the park by 10.15am and put into the public parking area.
