Self-contained campervans: freedom camping

You can stay in your certified self-contained campervan anywhere in Christchurch except for some prohibited areas. These include town centres, some residential settlements, Council parks and reserves.

Some areas are restricted to two nights in any 30 day period in a self-contained vehicle only.



Camping in a tent, or a vehicle without certified on-board facilities

You need to stay at a campground where there are facilities you can use. Camping in a tent or in a vehicle without certified on-board facilities is not permitted anywhere in Christchurch.

Dump stations: waste water

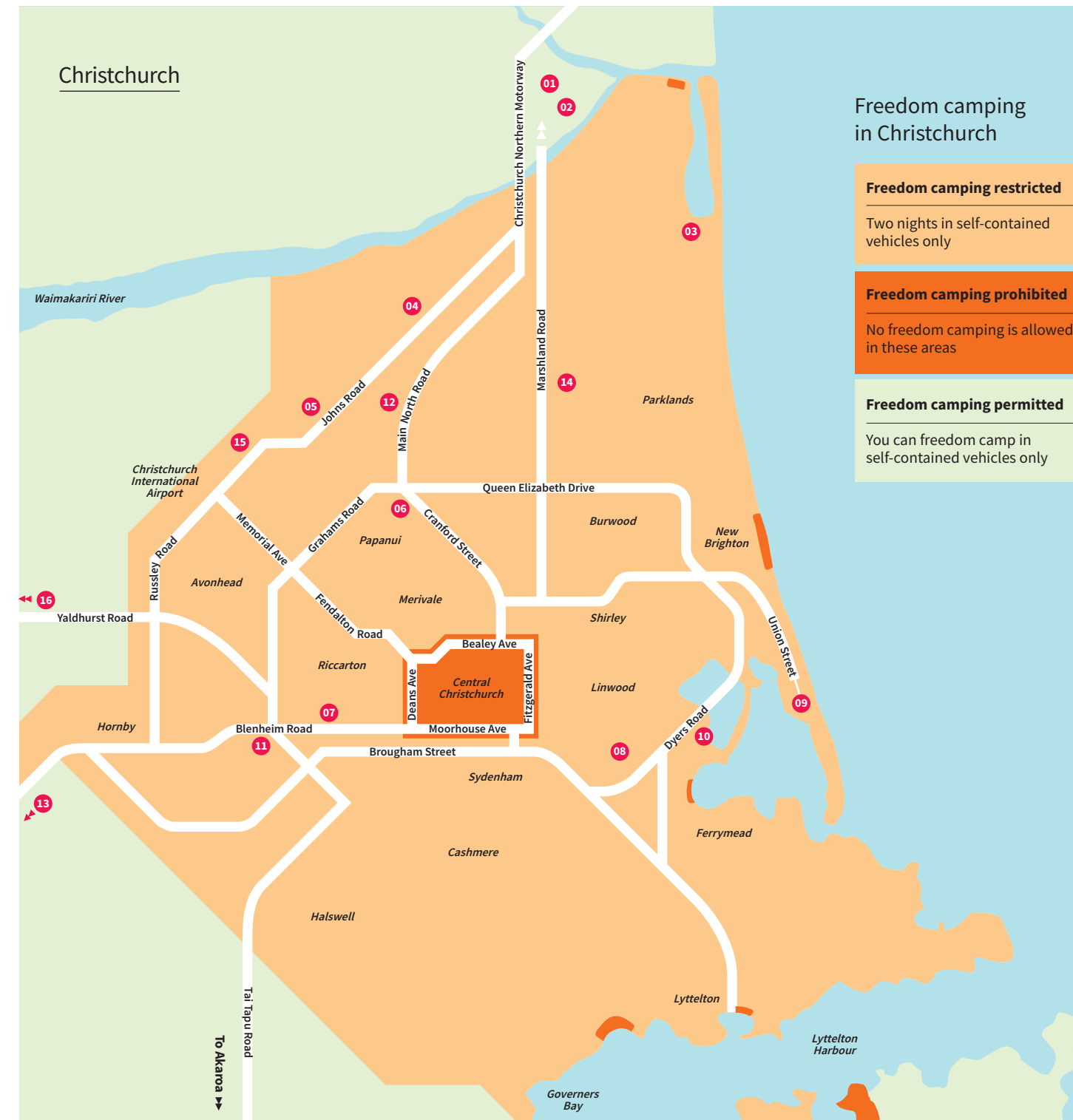
You need to empty the waste water from your campervan at a designated dump station. Some campgrounds have dump stations available for guests, otherwise you can use the free stations below:

- 14 BP Marshlands PDS**
Corner Prestons and Marshland roads, Christchurch
- 15 BP Russley Road PDS**
661 Russley Road, Harewood, Christchurch

68-90 North Terrace, Darfield

Self-contained campervans: freedom camping

You can stay in your certified self-contained campervan anywhere in the Banks Peninsula area except for some prohibited areas.

A Akaroa Freedom Camping area

This is the only area in the Akaroa township where freedom camping is allowed. Certified self-contained campervans can stay for up to two nights in any 30 day period. This is a popular location, and there are 18 parking spaces all fitted with sensors so that you can check the availability on the Campermate app.

Only one vehicle is allowed per marked parking space and all camping activities must be kept within the parking space. We keep an eye on this area every day.



Camping in a tent, or a vehicle without certified on-board facilities

You need to stay at a campground where there are facilities you can use. Freedom camping in a tent or in a vehicle without certified on-board facilities is not permitted anywhere in Akaroa or Banks Peninsula.

- 11 Recreation Ground – on Rue Brittan



Rubbish and recycling in and near Akaroa

You can use the rubbish and recycling bins located here:

- 11 Recreation Ground (by the toilets) – on Rue Brittan
- 12 Barrys Bay Transfer Station

- 04 Okains Bay Camping Ground



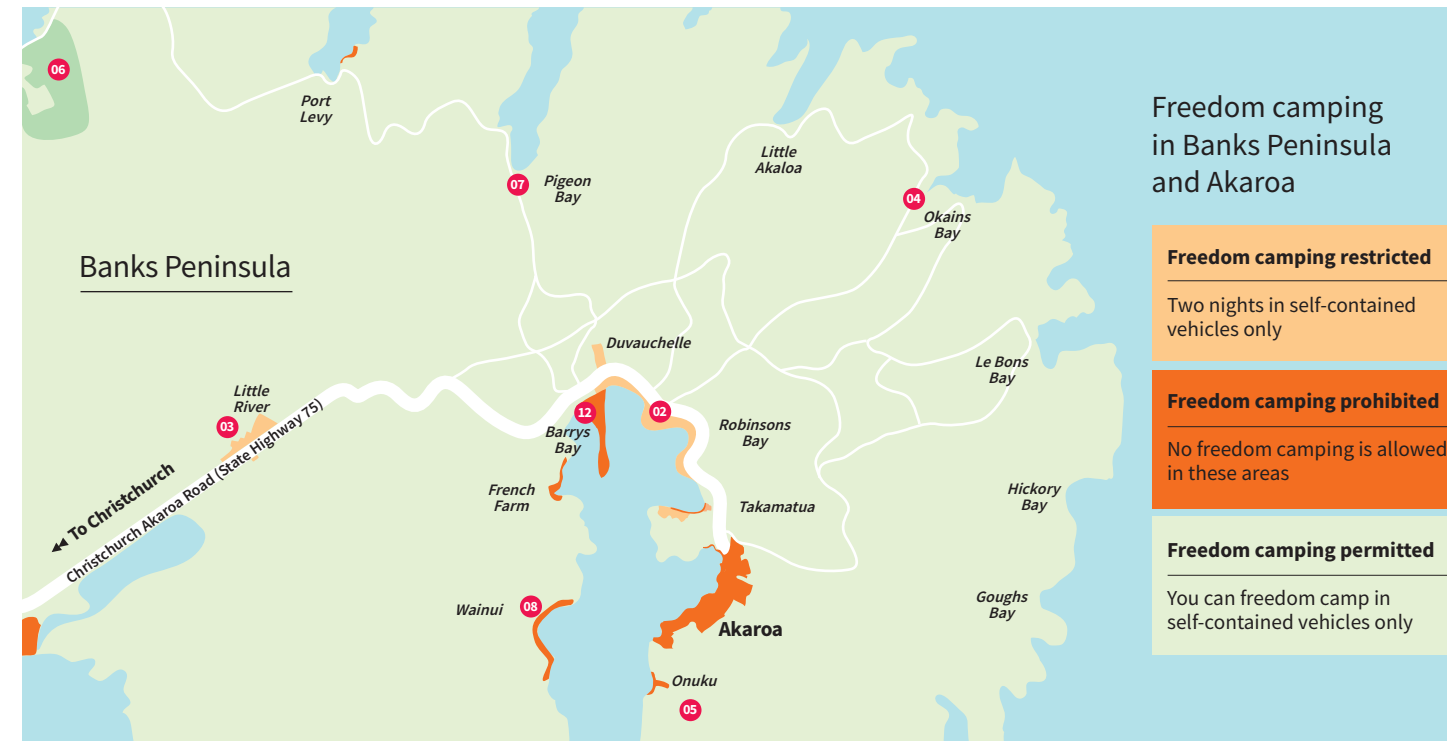
Narrow, steep and unsealed roads

Some of the roads in Akaroa and Banks Peninsula are narrow, steep and unsealed with limited places to turn around. For everyone's safety we advise that you don't travel on roads marked 'Not suitable for campervans' or '4WD drive only' unless you are in a suitable vehicle.
