Norah Street – Works starting and important rubbish bin collection information

Seipp Construction on behalf of Christchurch City Council are improving the storm water network in your neighbourhood. Work will be carried out between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday, with some Saturdays as required. As part of this work, there will be a two-staged road closure along Norah Street starting Monday 15 May 2017 (refer to map below).

The first stage of the road closure will be in place for approximately four weeks. Norah Street will be closed between the school gate to Ethne Street.

The second stage of the road closure will be on Norah Street between Ethne Street and Thames Street. This work will take approximately two weeks, starting as early as 9 June 2017 (subject to construction progress).

If you are living within the road closure area, there are a couple of things that we ask of you:

- **To prevent your car being blocked in**, please park your car outside the work area (24/7) for the duration of the road closure. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- **Rubbish collection:** please label your rubbish bins with your address and put them out for collection day at either end of the road closure. This will ensure your bins are able to be collected and identified by you to return home.
