After the state of emergency declared at 1800 on 15 February 2017 (and extended at 11.15am on 21 February 2017), I, **LIANNE AUDREY DALZIEL**, give notice of a local transition period for the Christchurch City and Selwyn districts, following the fire on the port hills and surrounding area.

The local transition period comes into force on the expiry of the state of emergency under section 71(4) of the Act, namely at 1800 on 1 March 2017 and ends at 1800 on 29 March 2017 unless extended or terminated earlier.
