



Freedom Camping is camping outside a camping ground within 200 metres of a motor vehicle accessible area or the mean low-water springs line of any sea or harbour, or on or within 200 meters of a formed road or a Great Walks Track; using a tent or other temporary structure, a caravan, a car, campervan, house-truck, or other motor vehicle. It does not include temporary and short-term parking of a motor vehicle, day-trip excursions, or resting or sleeping at the roadside in a caravan or motor vehicle to avoid driver fatigue.

Self-Contained Only
Certified self-contained vehicles only. No time limit

Self-Contained 2 Nights Only
Certified self-contained vehicles only for up to two nights per location in any 30-day period

No Camping
No camping of any kind

Self contained camping vehicles must display a current self-containment warrant issued under the New Zealand Standard for Self Containment of Motor Caravans and Caravans, NZS 5465:2001.

Restricted and prohibited freedom camping areas are defined by map and a written description of their locality. The written description is conclusive. If there is any inconsistency between the map and the description.
