Hearing: Christchurch City Council building on the 19 October 2015.

This is a decision concerning an application for a new Manager's Certificate by **Daniel Anisi Tyce**. The application was received on 10 August 2015 with the required documentation.

The Police have opposed the application on the grounds of suitability, pursuant to s. 222(a) of the Act as a result of two convictions for driving with excess breath alcohol, the most recent being on the 12 July 2011.

The applicant was contacted and advised that the matter was set down for a hearing on the 19 October 2015 at 11.30 am at the Council Building and the applicant failed to attend at that time.

As a result the Committee's decision was the application was refused on the grounds of none attendance at the hearing.

Sometime later that day the applicant contacted the City Council to advise he had mistakenly thought the hearing was at the Central Police Station so after attending there and having to wait sometime he found he was at the wrong place. By the time he found this out it was too late for him to get to the hearing by 11.30am.

As a result the applicant is advised that he can seek a rehearing and the matter will be heard at a later time.
