The Cycle Safe Programme aims to teach your child how to:

Grade 1

Wear a helmet correctly "Be Bright" on their bike Do a basic bike check Follow cycling laws in Aotearoa New Zealand Understand basic road rules Use their gears

On the court:

Use both brakes to come to a controlled stop Ride and manoeuvre with control Look behind over their shoulders Signal left and right and stay in control Ride slowly and with control Stop quickly if they need to

Grade 2

On the road:

Start and end a journey on a straight road Pass a parked car ("door and a bit more") Pass a side road from a main road Turn left into a side road Turn left out of a side road Turn right into a side road Turn right out of a side road Continue through a cross intersection Be aware of their surroundings Ride in the correct position on the road Use a roundabout Ride in a group and navigate give way signs, stop signs, traffic signals and roundabouts (if available in their

immediate school area).

Important notes:

- Bikes and helmets are required for ALL sessions.
- Your child's bike and helmet will be checked for safety before use. If they don't have a bike or helmet, Cycle Safe provides a limited number of bikes and helmets.
- Appropriate clothing and closed-toe footwear must be worn.
- Progression to the on-road sessions is dependent on meeting the required standard of on-court sessions.
