Manchester Street (Lichfield Street - Armagh Street)

End of Year Update

As we reach the end of 2016, the An Accessible City project on Manchester Street is 40% complete.

By 23 December 2016, the first section of An Accessible City on Manchester Street (Lichfield Street - Hereford Street) returns to two lanes of traffic, with trafficable asphalt laid. There will be some on-street car parks on the east and west side of Manchester Street. See Map one.

Programme for early 2017

Lichfield Street to Cashel Street

- Median kerb, final asphalt layer and line marking.
- Tile paving footpath on west side. This will require a 2-3 week closure of some car parks so that a temporary pedestrian walkway can be maintained. Prior warning will be provided to stakeholders.
- Landscaping from April 2017.

Cashel Street to Hereford Street

- Median kerb, final asphalt layer and line marking.
- Tile paving footpath on west side of Manchester Street.
- Landscaping from April 2017.

Hereford Street to Gloucester Street

- One lane traffic, southbound only on Manchester Street.
- One lane traffic, west bound only on Hereford Street.
- Kerb and channel work will continue.

Gloucester Street to Armagh Street:

- From Monday 9 January, traffic reduced to one lane on Manchester Street.
- One lane traffic, west bound only on Armagh Street.
- Storm water line construction begins.
- Rain garden construction on east side.

Christmas Closedown

- Friday 23 December, the work crew will be on a Christmas break. Work will resume on Monday 9 January. The worksite will be monitored during the break.
- Machinery will be removed from site and perimeter fencing reduced as much as possible.
- Traffic cones, lane closures and directional signage will still be in place.
- Pedestrians and drivers are to still take care when travelling around the worksite.
