- Tuam Street from Durham Street to Barbadoes Street, including Manchester Street from Lichfield Street to St Asaph Street

Christchurch’s Central City travel network gets another boost, with three Central City transport projects given the go-ahead.

Christchurch City Council has approved designs for three more Central City transport projects under the umbrella of *An Accessible City* – the transport chapter of the Christchurch Central Recovery Plan.

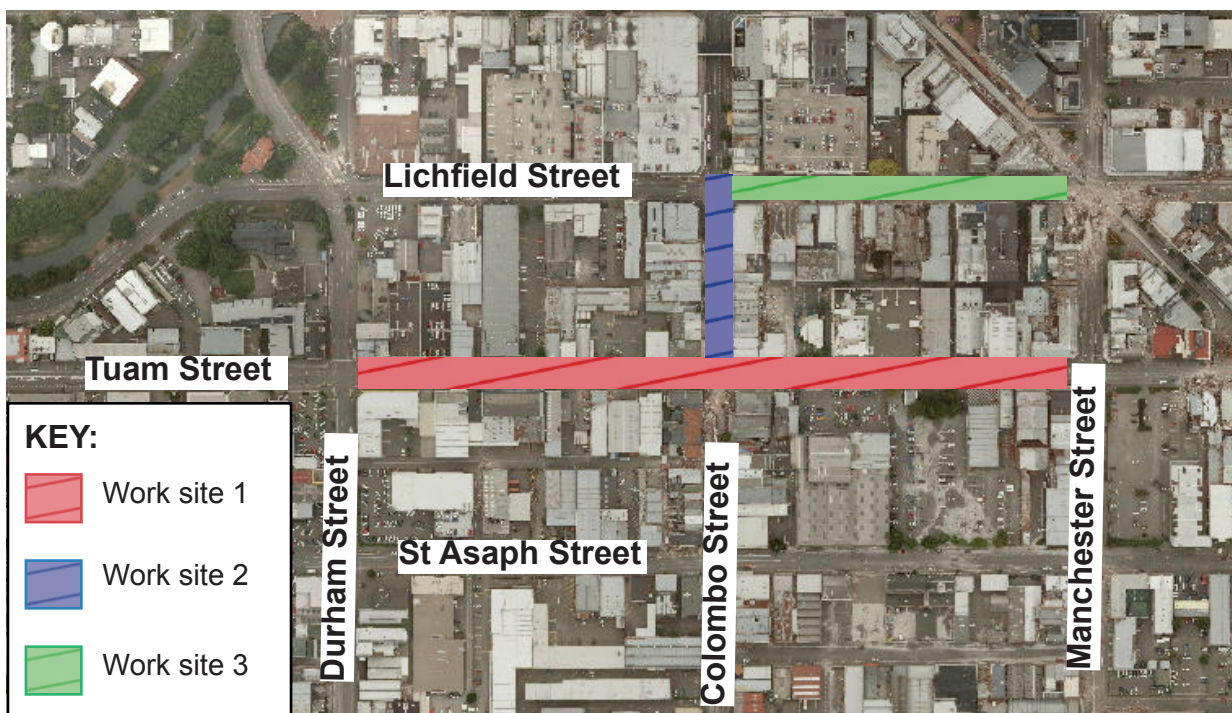

## Work on Tuam Street, Colombo Street and Lichfield Street

### Tuam Street:

Tuam Street from Durham Street to Manchester Street will be one-way eastbound. Work includes new kerbs, footpath, landscaping and road resurfacing.

### Lichfield Street:

Lichfield Street from Colombo Street to Manchester Street will be converted to two way traffic. Work includes new kerbs, footpath, landscaping and a full road reconstruction.

### Colombo Street:

Colombo Street from Tuam Street to Lichfield Street will be upgraded. Work includes new kerbs, footpath, landscaping and road resurfacing.

### Traffic impacts:

- There will be changes to the road layout during the work. Please be on the lookout for detour marked signage and VMS boards.
- There will be traffic delays associated with this work, please allow extra travel time for your journey.
- Access to businesses will be maintained throughout the work. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the work.
- Throughout the work there will be changes to on-street parking. There will be no on-street parking within the work sites.

### General impacts:

- Work will begin Monday 5 January to set up traffic management and do ground service investigations.
- Our standard work hours are Monday to Friday between the hours of 7.00am - 6.00pm. There will be some weekend and night work involved. We will notify you prior to the work starting.
